

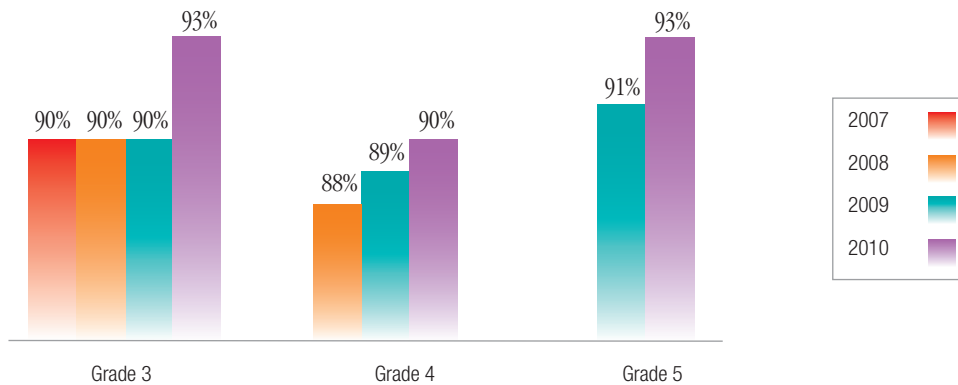

Prince William County adopted **Investigations in Number, Data and Space-2nd Edition** in the fall of 2007 for third grade, the fall of 2008 for fourth grade, and the fall of 2009 for grade 5. All three grades posted percentage gains over the course of their usage. From pre-usage to Spring 2010, grade 5 went from 91% to 93% students scoring proficient or advanced on the SOL while grade 3 and grade 4 went from 90% to 93% and 88% to 90%, respectively. Future reports will continue to track assessment results for the county.
