Students then apply the skill at their own level on adaptive activities.</p>
<p>Strengthen the academic program in the school.</p> 	<p>The program integrates all elements of language arts instruction, strengthening students' comprehension and 21st century skills and nurturing their critical thinking abilities through modeling, differentiated instruction, ongoing integrated assessments, and personalized reading and writing support.</p>
<p>Address the needs of all children in the school, but particularly the needs of those at risk of not meeting the challenging State academic standards.</p> 	<p><i>iLit</i> is an RTI and MTSS solution for Tier 2 and Tier 3 students. It engages students many years below grade level and English learners like no other reading program through mobile tablets, its vast library of high-interest nonfiction, instant support, engaging activities, and built-in reward systems that motivate students and track their progress. Teachers can use the program's Performance Dashboard to quickly see snapshots of the class's overall performance or drill down to see which skills an individual student has yet to master.</p>

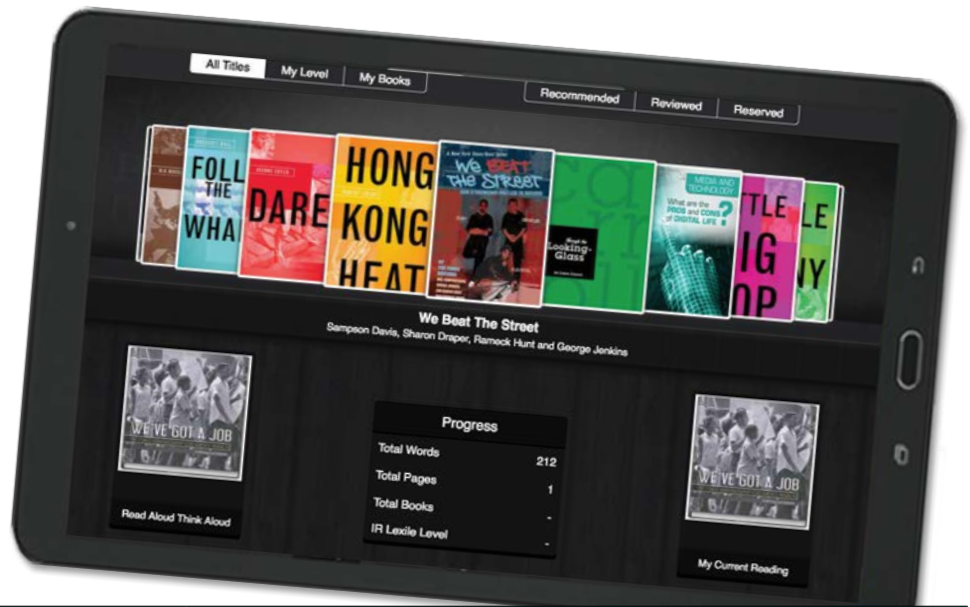
